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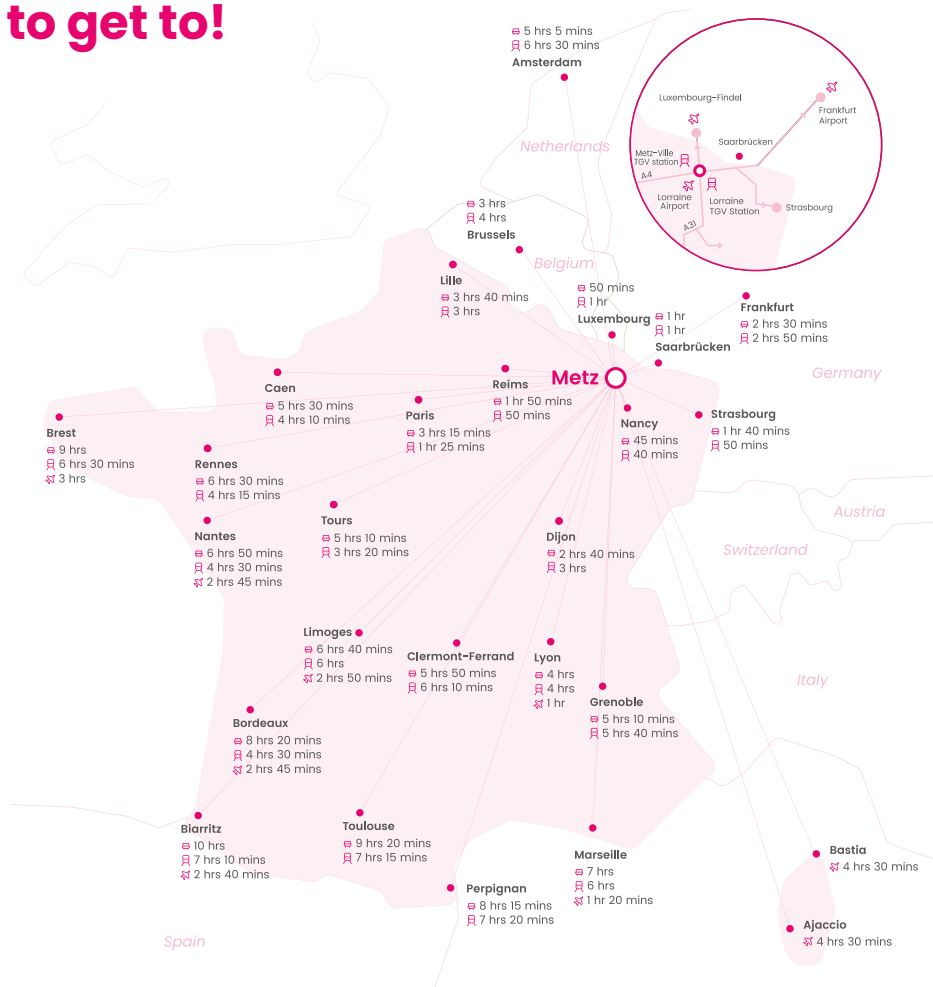

Public transport

The area's integrated public transport network offers different modes of transport and a seamless travel experience.

It is complemented by public cycle rental and car-sharing and supported by a real-time information service.

The **METTIS**, the Euro-Métropole de Metz's high-frequency bus service, operates spacious and practical articulated vehicles.

The METTIS runs in its own dedicated lanes, and forms the backbone of LE MET', the local transport network. The METTIS is neither a tram nor a standard bus – it's a **high-frequency bus service**. It's the most efficient way to travel in Metz and serves all the major locations you'll need to get to during your event.



By bicycle

The Euro-Métropole de Metz holds the "Territoire vélo" (cycle-friendly area) label, and there are numerous cycle lanes both inside and outside the city centre.

The public cycle hire service, known as **VÉLOMET'**, is the perfect way to get around during your visit.

A wide selection of cycles is available to meet all your needs, with urban bikes, folding bikes and e-bikes.

You can also make use of the self-service e-bike hire scheme, called **GraouLib'**. It's the flexible, practical, planet-friendly option, and it's great value too!



By car

Take the easy, sustainable approach to getting around within the Euro-Métropole de Metz by dropping your vehicle off at one of the **four park-and-ride car parks** on arrival and taking the METTIS.



By boat

In the Euro-Métropole de Metz, boats are a sustainable way to get around. Hop aboard **METZ'O**, the 100% eco-friendly electric river shuttle service.

Two electric boats operate a route from Metz city centre (Moyen Pont) to Moulins-lès-Metz via Le Saulcy, St-Symphorien, Longeville Centre and Scy-Chazelles.

Within 1 km of Metz Ville station (around 15 minutes' walk), you'll find:

• Most visitor venues

(event venues and hotels): Metz Congrès Robert Schuman Congress Centre, Centre Pompidou-Metz, Arsenal Jean-Marie Rausch Concert Hall, Le Royal and more.

• Some 1,260 hotel rooms in:

- five 4**** hotels (475 rooms),
- ten 3*** hotels (677 rooms) and
- three 2** hotels (108 rooms).

• Several must-see tourist sites:

including Centre Pompidou-Metz, Metz Cathedral and La Porte des Allemands (the Germans' Gate).

• Metz historic city centre:

with top-name retailers such as Galeries-Lafayette, independent boutiques and concept stores.

• **The Muse shopping centre, with around 30 restaurants** and over 100 shops spread over 37,000 sqm.

Must-see museums and arts venues

Metz has held “City of Art and History” status since 2011.

- **Centre Pompidou-Metz** is dedicated to modern and contemporary art with a focus on temporary exhibitions and a programme of live shows, film screenings, talks and more.

- **Cour d’Or Museum – Euro-Métropole de Metz** has 5,000 sqm of exhibitions space covering the city’s 3,000-year history. With more than 320 specimens on show, the Biodiversity Pavilion makes the museum’s natural history collections accessible to all.

It has been designed to get visitors thinking about biodiversity, display and conserve certain collections and develop research and knowledge transfer.

- **Metz Cathedral**, dedicated to Saint Stephen, is a must-see with its 6,500 sqm of stained-glass windows.

Metz and its rivers

Metz was built on the islands formed between the branches of the two rivers that flow through it, the Moselle and the Seille.

There are more than 500 hectares of water in the city, including an artificial lake created in 1974 on 7.2 hectares of meadows, with a network of paths. The artificial lake offers attractive views of the cathedral and the city's other key sites.

It hosts a varied programme of events throughout the year: the take-off of the Mongolfiades hot-air balloon gathering, the mirabelle plum festival fireworks, sports events and, since 2020, the water festival.

This label, administered by the “France Congrès et Événements” association, was launched in 2019 by the Ministry of the Ecological Transition following two G7 meetings in France, one of which was held in Metz on the theme of the environment and the oceans.

The aim of the label was to create a new benchmark highlighting **the commitment of cities and areas to sustainable tourism and eco-conscious events.**

Metz and the greater Metz area were among the first seven of the nine pilot areas to be awarded the label.

Since the outset, the project has been managed by Inspire Metz, and in particular the Convention Bureau and the Tourist Office.

It brings together all the players involved in both leisure tourism and business travel.

The Centre Pompidou-Metz, the Euro-Métropole de Metz, Metz Événements and UMIH57 (the Moselle hotel industry union) participated in the project as partners of Inspire Metz. They took concrete action to promote sustainable development within their organisations covering sustainable mobility, responsible purchasing, resource preservation, projects to reduce waste, inclusion, gender equality and more.







The Convention Bureau
